Are You Independent?

The dictionary defines *independent* as *free from outside control; not depending on another's authority. Capable of thinking and acting for oneself. Not connected with another or with each other.* As we celebrate Independence Day on July 4th, I pose a simple question; Are you *independent*? Are you free from outside control? Are you treated as though you are capable of thinking and acting for yourself?

When Jefferson drafted The Declaration of Independence he wrote, "That to secure these rights, governments are instituted among men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed". I believe Jefferson was saying the government is dependent upon the people for its authority. We, The People, should not be dependent upon government's authority. Jefferson then wrote, "That whenever any form of government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the Right of the People to alter or to abolish it, and to institute new government…". I believe Jefferson was simply telling us that it is our right to alter our form of government when it ceases to secure our rights and derive its just power from We, The People.

So, let me ask you the questions above in a different context. Are you free from the outside control of the state of Indiana government? Are you free from the outside control of the Indiana Republican Party? Does the Indiana General Assembly, the Governor of the State of Indiana, and the Attorney General of the State of Indiana treat you as though you are capable of thinking and acting for yourself? Are your individual rights secured by the government of the State of Indiana or are they being infringed? Who has the authority in Indiana, you or the government?

We, The People of the State of Indiana, must make a choice. Do we believe in independence or do we believe in the authority of the Indiana Republican Party, the Indiana General Assembly, the Governor of the State of Indiana, and the Attorney General of Indiana? Do they exist to secure our rights or to exert authority and control over us? Do the laws in the State of Indiana secure or restrict our rights? Will we continue to "suffer while evils are sufferable" or will we be among those who "right themselves by abolishing the forms to which they are accustomed".

I believe it is time to abolish our dependency upon authoritarianism in Indiana. It is time to declare Hoosier Independence in 2022 and right ourselves. I hope you will join me in celebrating our Hoosier independence on November 8, 2022.

On June 10th, Liberty Is Essential rallied in opposition of the university's unlawful requirement that all Indiana University students, faculty, and staff receive the new Covid-19 vaccine issued under an emergency-use authorization (EUA).

Liberty Is Essential PAC believes whether you make the personal choice to get vaccinated or the personal choice to not get vaccinated, the Indiana General Assembly passed legislation which restricts taxpayer-funded, government-owned agencies and institutions from enacting more restrictive mandates than have been enacted by the Governor. This legislation applies to government educational institutions.

Government-mandated health decisions are a violation of the Ninth, Tenth, and Fourteenth Amendments to the US Constitution.




