People often refer to Liberty when they mention the Declaration of Independence or the US Constitution. We have a statue on Ellis Island that invokes Liberty. Thomas Jefferson listed Liberty as one of the unalienable Rights endowed by their Creator to all men (humans). So, what is Liberty?

The dictionary defines Liberty as "the state of being free within society from oppressive restrictions imposed by authority on one's way of life, behavior, or political views." The word Liberty is a noun. The word is synonymous with independence, autonomy, and sovereignty. Liberty is something that we possess, or perhaps more appropriately, something we own.

Government does not bestow Liberty upon us. As a matter of fact, Thomas Jefferson clearly stated that the Creator provided Liberty to us and that it is an object that cannot be taken away from us or even given away by us. Let me reiterate meaning of unalienable (inalienable) - unable to be taken away from or given away by the possessor. You see, society cannot decide to forfeit Liberty because it is an unalienable Right. Even if you choose to subjugate yourself to the authority of someone else, you still possess Liberty. You cannot lose it and it cannot be taken from you.

Government's role is to secure and protect our Liberty. Once again, Thomas Jefferson made this clear in The Preamble to the Declaration of Independence when he said "That to secure these Rights, governments are instituted among men." Therefore, the only truly viable laws would be those which protect someone's Liberty, not attempt to restrict it. This concept is the basis for James Madison's assertion in the Fourteenth Amendment to the US Constitution that "nor shall any state deprive any person of life, liberty, or property, without the due process of law;". Our laws are supposed to be designed to protect our Rights and, therefore, when someone intentionally and willfully infringes upon our Rights, they can be lawfully deprived of theirs.

So, Liberty is an intangible possession that cannot be taken from us or given away by us. Yes, we can temporarily be deprived of Liberty as recompense for infringing on the Rights of others. However, that is a slippery slope which must be carefully and constantly monitored for abuses, because there is a very fine line between "secure these Rights" and "oppressive restrictions". We must be ever vigilant in protecting our Liberty.

Liberty is akin to Faith. You cannot see it. You cannot touch it. You can, however, perceive it. You must cherish it and protect it from those who would convince you that it doesn't exist and that you are somehow foolish for believing in its existence.

In subsequent chapters, I will discuss why our American government today, especially at the local and state government levels in Indiana today, are oppressively restrictive in a multitude of ways. I will discuss the oppressive nature of income taxes, property taxes, repetitive excise taxes, "public" education, occupational licensing, health department regulations, business licenses, building permits, zoning ordinances, tax increment financing, and many other government activities that are infringements on our Liberty.

Liberty is both the foundation of freedom and the cornerstone of the American Way of Life. If we allow government to deprive us of our Liberty, our freedom and way of life will crumble before us. Liberty is the single most important concept to protecting all of our other Rights. Liberty is essential!

On Wednesday, September 29th, Elizabeth Coquillard, Ty Shively and the Marshall County Libertarian Party partnered with Libertarian Party of Indiana District 2 and the Libertarian Party of Indiana to coordinate a rally in Bourbon, Indiana to support local resident Suzanne Afolabi.

Afolabi lost her family home back in May when an electrical fire broke out. The insurance company she is using has provided her a temporary trailer to live in while she waits for the insurance money for her new home. Unfortunately, some neighbors are not happy with the temporary home.

Neighbors and other locals of Bourbon, Indiana have complained to the zoning board in an effort to have Alfolabi's temporary home removed from her property while she awaits construction on a new home.

While the rally on September 29th attracted attention and support in the town, the final judgement has yet to be handed down from the zoning board which will take place at the town Zoning meeting on October 11th in Bourbon Indiana.
